Dear Mr. McNally:

Pursuant to Title 202 of the Physical Agreement, the Company proposes to cancel local agreement NC-98-25 and establish the schedules included in Attachment 1 for employees in the Dispatch Operations organization who are headquartered in Santa Rosa. This schedule change will serve to more closely align the hours of this service dispatch satellite center with other satellite centers as well as with the work schedules of gas field service employees.

We propose to begin these new schedules immediately.

Either the Union or Company reserves the right to cancel this agreement by giving 15 days written notice.

This proposal has been discussed with Larry Pierce, Union Business Representative.

NOTES:

- (1) Initial workweek schedule assignments are to be determined on the basis of Company service.
- (2) Since no vacancies currently exist, only Service Operators will be offered Service Operator schedules; and only Relief Service Operators will be offered Relief Service Operator schedules.
- (3) Vacant schedules which the Company intends to fill will first be successively offered internally to all incumbent Service Operators and Relief Service Operators on the basis of Company service. Those schedules which remain vacant after internal efforts to fill them have been exhausted will be filled externally in accordance with Title 205.
- (4) Service Operator schedules #1 #4 will be maintained on a rotating basis.
- (5) * Service Operator schedule #5 is Bob Olson's schedule and will not be covered as part of the rotation until Bob Olson returns from medical leave, is placed on LTD, or retires.
