Dear Mr. McNally:

As previously discussed between the parties, the Company has experienced unexpected difficulty in filling all of the fifty-five temporary additional outage radiation workers for the 2R9 refueling outage at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant scheduled to begin September 26, 1999.

For that reason, Company has contacted other nuclear power facilities to explore the possibility of borrowing skilled radiation protection technicians for the outage. The Seabrook plant, located in New Hampshire, has agreed to loan one of their Senior Health Physics Technicians, Mr. Jim Tilley, for use during the 2R9 outage.

Company proposes that it be allowed to use Mr. Tilley for the 2R9 outage on a agency- type relationship. During this assignment, Mr. Tilley will receive his regular rate of pay and per diem which is not less than that provided to outage Sr. Radiation Protection Technicians hired under letter agreement 91-20.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
