Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

Company has a number of Electric T&D projects that will be contracted out, and as in the past the Company has been requesting and using Hiring Hall journeymen to perform inspection work. This request is made once all reasonable efforts have been made to allow qualified regular journeyman to be trained, and to do this work on an annual basis. The inspection work requires the completion of a Company training program which a number of the hiring hall journey Lineman have completed. The Company proposes that a new Hiring Hall classification be established and paid at the GC Lineman rate. These individuals will have the journeyman qualifications, the appropriate Line (Transmission or Distribution) skill required to inspect the work, and completion of the Company inspector training. If there are insufficient fully qualified Hiring Hall applicants due to the lack of the inspector training, the Company further proposes to provide Company Inspector training to those Hiring Hall applicants who have journeyman and Line Transmission and Distribution skills.
