Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

Pursuant to Section 112.15 of Physical Agreement, Company proposes to return Mr. Artis F. McHugh, a previous Communications Tech GC in Cottonwood, from Long Term Disability to a Telecommunications Equipment Installer at Auburn as Cottonwood no longer exists as a Point of Assembly.

Mr. McHugh's wage rate will be \$1405.35 per week. The wage rate was adjusted in accordance with Subsection 112.10(c) of the Physical Agreement. Mr. McHugh will have accelerated (306.9-Physical) rights as stipulated in Subsection 112.10(d) to return to Communications Tech GC.

Mr. McHugh's return to work is contingent on compliance with certain recommendations made by Dr. Stephen Raffle. Mr. McHugh will be required to provide a negative return to work drug test and be subject to up to four unannounced drug tests within the first twelve months following return to the active payroll. There will be other ongoing obligations that will be monitored by EAP. Failure to maintain compliance or refusal to take a drug test will subject Mr. McHugh to immediate termination. A first positive drug test will result in Mr. McHugh being placed in the First Time Offender Program.
