Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The parties previously agreed to establish a Hiring Hall Installer/Meter Reader classification in Letter Agreement 07-06 which was initiated due to a specific need in the Bakersfield area. The position is designed to supplement the Installer volunteers that transition from meter reading. The initial number of volunteers compared to the actual number of acceptances reporting for the positions have diminished substantially resulting in a shortage of manpower to perform this work. As a result, the Company is currently re-soliciting the meter reading workforce to identify any additional volunteers. In the event no additional volunteers are identified, the Company proposes sourcing the Installer/Meter Reader position through the Hiring Hall on a system-wide basis with an expectation to begin addressing needs arising as soon as May or June of this year.

This proposal has been reviewed with Assistant Business Manager Dorothy Fortier.

This agreement may be cancelled by either party upon 60 days written notice to the other of such cancellation.
