Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes Company's proposed letter agreement No. 80-17-PGE, dated March 17, 1980. Pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to make changes in the work schedules of the Production Section and the Scheduling and Control Section of Computer Operations.

In order to provide adequate service, Company proposes to establish a third shift with a basic workweek of Wednesday through Sunday (i.e., starting Tuesday at 11:45 p.m. and ending Sunday at 7:45 a.m.). The composition of such shift will initially include one Console Operator, one Senior Operator, and four to five Computer Operators or COIT's. Company may add additional Console-Senior-Computer Operators as required. Employees on third shift will be given preference for transfers between workweek schedules on a normal seniority basis.

This change has already been instituted, pursuant to a local agreement signed May 22, 1980. However, the establishment of a regular work schedule for such employees, which continues through Sunday, necessitates agreement between the Manager of Industrial Relations and IBEW Business Manager. The agreement proposed here will resolve this technicality.
