Gentlemen:

A field garage is being established in Pittsburg to relieve farm-out costs and transporting vehicles and equipment to the Oakland and Davis Service Centers for major repair. Field Garage Mechanics, lubrication personnel, and hydraulic repairmen servicing the Contra Costa area will be headquartered at Pittsburg along with three crane crews that are responsible for crane repairs throughout the Pacific Gas and Electric Company system.

In order to provide an adequate parts supply for these various functions, a parts room will be established at the Pittsburg Field Garage. The operation of the parts room will be similar to the control system recently integrated into the Davis and Oakland Service Centers.

Therefore, the Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 304.4 of the Physical Agreement, to establish a Field Partsman classification. Such classification will be responsible for the administrative and physical job duties of the parts room. These duties will be similar to those found in the Partsman (SC) job description.

In addition, the proposed wage scale and Lines of Progression for
the Field Partsman classification will be as follows:
