Gentlemen:

Mr. R. L. Rodgers was employed on August 17, 1966. In 1971, while an Electrician with General Construction, he suffered an aneurysm and went on Long Term Disability. In 1974 he returned to the active payroll as a Field Clerk in General Construction but later returned to LTD on October 1, 1975.

On June 6, 1977 Mr. Rodgers returned to work following Company-Union agreement for his placement in a Utility Transformer Repairman's classification in Santa Rosa (see attached Letter Agreement, dated May 6, 1977).

On January 22, 1979 Mr. Rodgers prebid into an Apprentice Electrician classification at the Geysers Power Plant. He was subsequently not able to advance in that classification as he was not able to meet the requirements of the apprentice training program and was placed in a temporary additional Materialsman vacancy at Rohnert Park on June 9, 1980 on a trial period basis. However, he continues to have difficulties with his memory; and his work performance in that classification is unsatisfactory. Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Rodgers a Transformer Repairman classification at the Rohnert Park Materials Facility. Mr. Rodgers' bidding rights within his normal line of progression will be restricted until such time as he demonstrates that he is physically qualified for promotion.
