Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our 81-4-PGE proposal dated, January 13, 1981.

The Department of Engineering Research is required to perform field, biological and laboratory studies at Diablo Canyon Power Plant; and as a result, it has become necessary to establish mechanical support positions at the plant site. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement, to establish the following classification at Diablo Canyon Power Plant.

Utility Equipment Mechanic (Department of Engineering Research)

An employee who is a journeyman and who performs all types of tool, equipment and automotive maintenance and repair work including welding; completes job tags and performs other paper work in connection with his job. His background of apprenticeship and experience must be such as to qualify him to perform these duties with skill and efficiency.

Further, this classification, as a primary function, will perform marine engineer (outboard gasoline and diesel inboard) maintenance and repair of all Department of Engineering Research vessels. Required skills include welding, equipment fabrication, and vessel hull repair.

This classification, for the purposes of Wages and Titles 205 and 206, will be considered the same as Equipment Mechanic (1255), General Services Department.

Currently, Mr. D. H. Hibner, Field Garage Mechanic, Level A, of General Construction Services Department has been assigned to the Department of Engineering Diablo Canyon Biology Laboratory and is fully qualified to perform the duties of the proposed classification. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Hibner into the Utility Equipment Mechanic's classification upon execution of this Agreement.
