Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.16 of the Physical Agreement description 10.7 of the Clerical Agreement, to change the hours of work in the Concordate, Coalinga, and Lemoore headquarters of Kings District.

It is proposed to change the hours of work each year during the summer from the first Monday in June through the last Friday in September from the regular hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon and 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. to new hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for all electric crew employees in these headquarters in addition to all Senior Metermen in Kings District (Selma, Corcoran, Lemoore).

The proposed hours change for Troublemen at each headquarters would be from their present hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. to new hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 12 noon to 4:00 p.m.

It is also requested that the Foreman's Clerks' hours be changed from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. to new hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 12 noon to 4:00 p.m. (There is no Foreman's Clerk in Lemoore.)

All hours will revert to their present hours for the balance of the year.

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon 30 days' advance notice to the other of such intended termination.
