The grievance concerned the utilization of Electricians and Apprentice Electricians in temporary upgrades to Electrical Technician when assigned to test power and/or control circuits at the Diablo Canyon Project. In the light of the circumstances presented, the Committee agreed that the most equitable solution to the case would be to temporarily upgrade the grievants to the Electrical Technician classification while they are performing the work in question at Diablo Canyon.

As this situation is a continuing one, the Company proposes that the 20-consecutive day limit on temporary upgrades provided for in Section 305.4 be waived with respect to the performance of the work in question at Diablo Canyon.
