Gentlemen:

This will cancel and supersede our previous letter to you dated April 14, 1983.

The town of Amboy has 15 gas accounts and the service work load is very sporadic. The nearest Division Gas Serviceman is headquartered at Boron, San Joaquin Division, approximately 120 miles from Amboy. Pipeline Operations' Topock transmission maintenance personnel are frequently working in the proximity of Amboy as Line 300 A and B travel through the area. Also, Topock is located 35 miles closer to Amboy than Boron.

Pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to assign Mr. Ernest Armijo, Gas Control Mechanic, Topock Pipeline Operations, to assist with routine and emergency gas service calls for the town of Amboy. Mr. Armijo has successfully completed the Gas Serviceman's Training School and is now qualified to be assigned gas service work. Such an arrangement will not compromise the existing Gas Serviceman complement within the Division.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
