Gentlemen:

On July 1, 1983, George Perazzo, a San Francisco Division employee, was awarded an Operating Clerk position in the Gas Department at 18th and Shotwell. Mr. Perazzo was formerly a Utility Clerk at the Clerk D rate of pay, headquartered in the General Services Department at 225 Folsom, and had held this position since his employment date of December 18, 1978.

Shortly after reporting to the Operating Clerk position, it became apparent to Mr. Perazzo and his supervisors that he was substantially unqualified to adequately perform the duties of the Operating Clerk position, and Mr. Perazzo subsequently requested that he be allowed to return to his former classification in order to avoid potential demotion.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to rescind Mr. Perazzo's job award of July 1, 1983, and return him to his former classification at the Clerk D rate of pay without precedent to any future situations. As there is currently a Utility Clerk vacancy at Mr. Perazzo's former headquarters, Company believes this action would be the most equitable solution to this situation in that it would accommodate both the needs of the Company and wishes of the employee.
