Gentlemen:

The following proposal is based upon discussions between Company and Union Committees concerning bidding rights and displacement of employees headquartered at Avon, Martinez, Oleum and Kern Power Plants. As a result of those meetings, Company proposes the following pursuant to Title 206, Subsections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement.

Attached as Exhibit I is the proposed normal line of progression for the Steam Generation Department in the application of Title 206.

### Relocation Benefits

It was agreed that the Company will pay the moving allowance for employees who voluntarily accepted a lateral assignment or demotion, prior to official notification that all employees at Avon, Martinez, Oleum and Kern Power Plants were given Section 206.9 bidding rights, which required them to move as follows:

Kern Power Plant - Beginning October 18, 1985 to the completion of the relocation of all employees.
AM&O - Beginning April 18, 1984 to the completion of relocation of all employees.

### Delay and Release Dates

Because of operating needs there may be significant delays in releasing some AM&O and Kern employees who are awarded positions. If an employee is delayed, the Company will give such employee one month notice before releasing him or her if the employee is required to relocate.

# Filling Positions Within Steam Generation

It is understood that the Company will release some positions to be filled only by bidders within the Steam Generation Department.

## Voluntarily Transfers to Other Line of Progression

The last paragraph of Subsection 206.9(b) of the Physical Agreement will apply as follows: "An employee who has been demoted or transferred under the provisions of this Title who thereafter voluntarily removes himself from the line of progression to which he was previously transferred or demoted shall not be given consideration under this Section."

## Retention of Subsections 205.5(d)(1) and 18.5(c)(1) Rights

In accordance with Title 206, those employees displaced or demoted as a result of relocation because of the retirement of AM&O or the cold stand-by of Kern Power Plant will be considered to be headquartered within their previous Division in the application of Subsections 205.5(d)(1) or 18.5(c)(1). These rights will be valid for a period of one year following their report date. However, if at any time, an employee declines an opportunity to return to his or her previous Division, his or her Subsections 205.5(d)(1) and 18.5(c)(1) rights will be voided. For example, if a Control Operator bids to another Division as a Control Operator as result of relocation, such Control Operator could return to a beginning position in his/her previous Division as a priority two transfer applicant. For purposes of this agreement, "Division" is the bidding Division in which the plant is geographically located.


