Gentlemen:

On February 1, 1984, Mr. Holbrook Magee was placed as a Pressure Operator pursuant to a Letter Agreement under the provisions of Section 205.19. At the time, Mr. Magee was permanently precluded from returning to his Gas Crew Foreman position as a result of an industrial back injury. Had the parties agreed to the rehabilitation placement under the provisions of 206.12, Mr. Magee would have had 206.9 rights to Gas Crew Foreman. Mr. Magee has recently provided the Company with evidence that he is capable of performing the duties of the Gas Crew Foreman classification.

Company proposes therefore, pursuant to Section 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to grant Subsection 206.9(a) and (b) rights to Mr. Holbrook Magee to the Gas Crew Foreman classification and to other intermediate classifications in that same line of progression for which he is qualified. Mr. Magee's 206.9(a) rights would be to San Rafael.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
