Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter dated May 3, 1990 on the same subject. Pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b) Company proposes to establish a 2140 Transformer Repairman classification in the Materials Distribution Line of Progression. Company therefore proposes to modify the Electric and Utility section of the Materials Distribution line of progression by adding the following:

2135 TRANSFORMER REPAIRMAN

An employee in the shop who repairs, services, and maintains transformers. He may also be required to overhaul and repair various other types of electrical equipment and tools for which he is qualified to perform.
