## Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 202.16 of the Physical Agreement, the company proposes a permanent change of hours and work schedules for six Troublemen headquartered in Russian River Division, Santa Rosa headquarters as follows:

Clarence Lua	0700 - 1730	Wednesday - Saturday (10/4)
Cliff Hall	0700 - 1730	Sunday - Wednesday (10/4)
Dave Cook	1500 - 2300	Monday - Friday (5/2)
Roger Cooney	0700 - 1530	Monday - Friday (5/2)
Bob Puckett	0630 - 1500*	Monday - Friday (5/2)
Larry Schuldt	0630 - 1500*	Monday - Friday (5/2)

\*Work hours will change to 0700 - 1530 consistent with the Winter hours schedule of the Electric T&D Department.

In addition, the company proposes to implement the following administrative procedures:

- 1. Troublemen, with the supervisor's approval, will be permitted to exchange work schedules once in a six month period. Yard seniority will prevail if more than one Troubleman is interested in an exchange. An exchange will not result in overtime and will become effective when the provisions of Section 208.18 are met.
- 2. Permanently vacated schedules will be offered to the Troublemen at the headquarters, based on yard seniority, prior to implementing the provisions of Title 205.
- 3. At the supervisor's discretion, Dave Cook will be permitted to temporarily transfer to day schedules during vacation increments of five days or more.
- 4. No change to the overtime call-out procedure will occur. Troublemen will continue to be called out on a rotating basis; i.e., the No. 1 Troubleman on call drops to No. 6 at the conclusion of the call-out period; the No. 2 Troubleman moves to No. 1 on-call, etc.

This agreement may be cancelled by either party with 30 days written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing agreement thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the company.
