Gentlemen:

Currently several journeymen IBEW members of Gas Transmission and Storage are under consideration for exempt positions with the Pipeline Expansion Project. These positions are temporary by nature and will likely last from one to two years. Under present organization, these project positions are employed by Pacific Gas Transmission Company.

GT&S wishes to facilitate these developmental opportunities for its employees, yet preserve their employment security rights they currently possess by waiving the provisions of Section 206.10(c) of the Physical Agreement. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 206.12, to allow the effected employees to return to their current classification and headquarters upon completion of their assignment, with no loss of seniority or service, without requirement for a vacancy to exist. Company shall fill the vacancy created by the employee transferring to the project, and department vacancies resulting from the backfill; no employee
