Gentlemen:

Since the Company is replacing the CES 9400 payment processing machines in the General Office Payment Processing Center with an Intelligent Character Recognition payment processing system (referred to as an ICR system) and the Company is planning to begin training Utility Machine Operators assigned to the Processing Unit on the ICR System in February, Union proposes that those employees being trained on the ICR System who are not currently earning BAP receive the average weekly BAP payout of those employees processing on the 9400s.

Union further proposes that those employees being trained on the ICR System who are currently earning BAP receive their individual BAP average (average to be determined using the three-month period immediately prior to the commencement of training). Employees processing on the 9400s will continue to receive the actual BAP pay for which they qualify.

An example of how the average BAP payment will be calculated for those employees in training with <u>no</u> individual BAP average is shown below:

During the week of March 6 - March 12, 250 total hours of BAP is earned by 14 employees. 250 divided by 14 = 17.85 hours. Employees being trained on the ICR System would receive 17-3/4 hours BAP pay.
