Company has expressed an urgent need for temporary Operators at the Geysers Power Plant. The Plant is currently retro-fitting the burners at certain units and this work has put a strain on the current manpower at the Geysers.

The Union proposes to have Company seek temporary Operators from the Hiring Hall in accordance with Letter Agreement R1-95-145-PGE, except that in this case, the use of these temporary Operators will not be considered as contracting under Section 207.2 of the Agreement. This agreement will expire on December 31, 1996.
