Company proposes to extend the San Jose Call Center pilot on Call Quality Monitoring agreed to in Letter Agreement 99-12 an additional 90 days to August 11, 1999.

During this extended pilot period, the Company will continue to not use the numerical rating scale included on the Call Quality Monitoring forms. The intent of this pilot is to determine whether omitting the rating scale will help employees focus on qualitative feedback versus a quantitative rating.
