Pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to establish, on a trial basis, a ten-hour, four-day workweek in the Technical Maintenance work group at McDonald Island, Pipe Line Operations. This trial will begin on January 5, 1987, and continue through May 31, 1987.

The classifications and number of employees are as follows: two Gas Transmission Technicians; five Gas Control Mechanics; one Apprentice Gas Control Mechanic; four Transmission Mechanics; and one Maintenance Assistant.

The work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. with a one-half hour lunch period from 12 noon to 12:30 p.m. The basic workweeks shall be Monday through Thursday and Tuesday through Friday.

The Maintenance Assistant position will be involved in this agreement. Should it be determined that effective coverage of the phones, warehouse, PC, and clerical procedures cannot be maintained with the inclusion of this classification into this schedule, the Maintenance Assistant position will resume the regular work schedule within two weeks of either party so indicating in writing to the other.

The provisions of generic Letter Agreement R1-86-37-PGE shall be applicable to this trial.

Additionally, a joint committee comprised of two appointees by Union and two appointees by Company shall meet on a bi-monthly basis to review the test program and schedule.
