Gentlemen:

Company proposes to amend Letter Agreement R1-88-121 concerning production standards and the Bonus Achievement Program (BAP) in the Payment Processing Center as follows:

- 1. Payment Processing Center employees will perform extraction and processing duties daily, except for those employees on the extras list. Company will continue the pre-June 1993 practice of distributing processing work as equitably as possible to all employees.
- 2. Employees will be eligible for a BAP payout if they meet a weekly production standard of 25,650 items (760 items x 33.75 available hours). This standard will be reduced if an operator has less than 33.75 available hours, in which case, their actual hours will be multiplied by 760 to determine the weekly production standard.
- 3. Implementation of this new production standard will occur on August 1, 1993.
- 4. Company and Union have discussed Paragraph I(C) of Letter Agreement 88-121 and the intent of the parties concerning its application to new equipment that will replace the 9400's. The parties have been unable to reach agreement on this issue and have therefore determined that Letter Agreement R2-93-51 is agreed to without prejudice and shall not be referenced by either party in future discussions on this issue.
- 5. Except for the change in production hours noted in paragraph 2 above, the provisions of Letter Agreement R1-88-121 will remain in effect.

In addition, Company proposes to cancel and supersede Letter Agreement 93-45 concerning hours of work in the Payment Processing Center. Effective August 1, hours and shifts for the Payment Processing Center are:

Since all employees will be eligible for the incentive plan and shift times will change, graveyard and existing 4:00 a.m. personnel will be given a chance to sign for their shift preference.

Either party may cancel the hours portion of this letter agreement by providing the other party 30 days written notice.
