GUIDELINES FOR DEVELOPING REVERSE LINES OF PROGRESSION FOR USE IN THE APPLICATION OF SECTION 206.3

Guidelines

- 1. The reverse order of the *normal* line of progression is defined as the successively lower classifications in the department and headquarters affected by the lack of work situation.
- 2. Reverse *line of progression (*RLOP*)* for the classification affected shall include classifications in the department shown in the "Next Lower" column of the Job Definition/Lines of Progression. (See Note.)
- 3. The reverse LOP should normally only include classifications equal to or lower than the top rate of pay of the classification. Top rate of pay should be used to determine equal to or lower for all classifications considered. Note: Top rate of pay should be exclusive of a site allowance, e.g., Helms', and Diablo Canyon rates which are increased based on time headquartered at the location.
- 4. Critical classifications will be treated the same as their base classification. For example, a 1118 Critical Lineman is considered the same classification as 1100 Lineman for purposes of Sections 206.3 and 206.4.
- 5. Relief classifications will be treated the same as their base classification. For example, a Relief System Operator will be considered the same classification as a System Operator for purposes of Sections 206.3 and 206.4.
- 6. On a case by case basis, other classifications may be added to expand options for the classification affected, but not necessarily in its *normal* line of progression. For example the *normal* line of progression for the 0560 Fitter is as follows:

0930 Utility Worker to 0561 Apprentice Fitter to 0560 Fitter

However, other classifications may be added to expand the options for the Fitter, such as adding the 1645 Equipment Operator and 0465 Heavy Truck Driver

7. The reverse LOPs listed in this document are the basis for the Employee Election Forms used by affected employees in the 206 process to indicate their displacement preferences. Any changes made to the reverse LOPs should also be changed on the corresponding Employee Election Form.

DEMOTION AND LAYOFF PROCEDURE APPLICABLE TO OPERATORS IN STEAM AND NUCLEAR POWER GENERATION DEPARTMENTS

In order to provide for the uniform application of the Demotion and Layoff Procedure of the Agreement within the Steam and Nuclear Power Generation Departments and at the same time to provide a full staff of trained Operators in each plant, the following definitions and procedure shall apply when operating employees in the Departments are to be demoted due to lack of work.

I. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

- A. The terms "same classification" and "Next lower classification in the reverse order order of the normal Line of Progression" as used in Title 206 of this Agreement shall be determined by the following table:

DEMOTION AREA

II. PROCEDURE

A. When an employee is to be demoted due to lack of work, other than by a reason of the shutdown of a plant or the discontinuance of one or more shifts in a plant, the procedure outlined in Title 206 of this Agreement shall be followed and the foregoing definitions shall apply. Demotions made under Section 206.3 will be at the plant where the job has been eliminated. Elections to displace an employee with less Company seniority in the same classification under Section 206.4 will be to classifications in the same step as the employee's own classification as shown in the above table.

Exception: Placement at Diablo Canyon Power Plant in classifications above *Nuclear Operator* require an active NRC nuclear license.

B. The following procedure shall apply when operating employees are to be displaced due to the shutdown of a plant or the discontinuance of one or more shifts in a plant.

DEMOTION AND LAYOFF PROCEDURE APPLICABLE TO OPERATORS IN STEAM AND NUCLEAR POWER GENERATION DEPARTMENTS (continued)

- 1. Before one or more shifts is discontinued or a plant is shutdown, Company, following discussion with Union, shall decide how many employees in each operating classification and in each plant in the *Demotion Area* may be displaced. A list shall then be prepared showing such information and it shall be posted in the plants to be affected.
- 2. An employee who, instead of being demoted in his/her own plant under Section 206.3 or instead of being laid off, elects under Section 206.4 to displace an employee in another plant shall from such list indicate in the order of his/her preference the plants in which he/she elects to displace another employee. Company will endeavor to effect transfers in accordance with the employee's selections on the basis of the classification he/she holds and his/her Company seniority, using the above Table to determine his/her same classification.
- 3. After an employee has displaced an employee in another plant, Company will assign him/her to duties at such plant which it considers him/her qualified to perform, and pay him/her the wage rate of the classification to which he/she has been transferred. Company will then provide instruction and training in an endeavor to qualify him/her to perform the duties of such classification. When he/she is qualified, Company shall assign him/her to the job duties for which he/she has been trained, but in no case shall his/her total training period exceed six months from the date his/her first transfer was effected.
- 4. If, at the end of such six month period, Company considers that he/she is not qualified to perform the duties of the classification to which he/she was transferred, he/she shall be demoted in the same plant to a lower classification which he/she is qualified to fill and shall be paid the wage rate of such classification. Should a question arise with respect to his/her qualifications, the matter shall be referred to the grievance procedure within ten days of the date on which he/she was demoted to such lower classification.
- 5. The placement of an employee who is displaced by the application of paragraphs 2 and 3 shall be governed by paragraphs 2 through 4 inclusive. The placement of an employee who is displaced by the application of paragraph 4 shall be governed by Section A.

Exception: Placement at Diablo Canyon Power Plant in classifications above *Nuclear Operator* require an active NRC nuclear license.

C. In the administration of the procedure outlined in Section B, Demotion Areas 33 and 34 shall be considered as one Demotion Area.

DEMOTION AND LAYOFF PROCEDURE APPLICABLE TO OPERATORS IN STEAM AND NUCLEAR POWER GENERATION DEPARTMENTS (continued)

III. ACCELERATED PROMOTION, WAGE RATES AND SENIORITY

- A. As provided for in Section 206.9(b) of this Agreement, the accelerated promotion rights of an employee who has been demoted and transferred to another plant under the procedure of paragraph II above shall be as follows:
 - 1. In the plant to which an employee has been demoted and transferred, his/her accelerated promotion rights shall be to the same step as the classification he/she held before he/she was demoted; if there is no classification in the same step, to a classification in the next lower step where there is a classification. Such accelerated rights may not be exercised unless he/she is qualified to perform all the duties of the classification to which he/she was transferred, after receiving the training provided for in paragraph II-B-3 above.
 - 2. In the plants other than the one to which he/she was transferred under the procedure of paragraph II above, his/her accelerated promotion rights shall be to that classification to which he/she had bidding rights under Section 205.7(b) or (c) before he/she was demoted.
- An employee who is demoted into a classification which he/she has not previously held, or who is promoted to such classification under the provisions of Section 206.9(b) shall be given the top wage rate for such classification.
