
Pursuant to Section 206.17 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to relocate four Measurement and Control Mechanics, three Corrosion Mechanics, and four Gas T&D Helpers from the Montgomery Street Service Center to the Cupertino Service Center in San Jose Division.

Attached please find a copy of the local agreement between Mr. D. J. Coyne, Labor Relations Supervisor, San Jose Division, and Mr. B. Twohey, Union Business Representative serving San Jose Division, which details the reasons for relocation.

The relocation will be implemented on or about November 1, 1982, unless Company receives written notification of Union's objection within ten days of the date of this letter.

Dear Mr. Twohey:

As you are aware, prior to December 1981, Central District-San Jose Division encompassed all of Santa Clara County. On December 1, 1981, Gas and Electric T&D, Customer Services, and Marketing were divided into two separate Districts. Central District continued to be headquartered in San Jose, the new District, De Anza, was headquartered at 10860 North Blaney Avenue, Cupertino. At that time, the Gas Measurement and Control group was not divided because no facilities were available at De Anza District.

At the present, Gas Measurement and Control group, for both Districts, is headquartered at Montgomery Street in San Jose. By this letter we propose to continue the District split process by relocating under Title 206.17 of the Labor Agreement, approximately 40% of the Gas Measurement and Control group from the Montgomery Street Service Center to the Cupertino Service Center.

The following is the specific breakdown of the positions to be relocated:

- 1) Four (4) Measurement and Control Mechanics
- 2) Three (3) Corrosion Mechanics

In addition, since approximately ten Gas T&D Helpers are regularly assigned to the Gas Measurement and Control group in San Jose, we also propose that four Gas Helpers be relocated to the Cupertino Service Center under Title 206.17. This action will complete the relocation process, and will not require any additional changes.

I propose that upon your concurrence, we will present this proposal to both Mr. I. W. Bonbright and Mr. J. McNally for their concurrence. The estimated implementation date for this change is November 1, 1982. If you concur with this change, please sign at the bottom and return.
