

The annual survey of reasonable costs for Traveling Maintenance Crews has been completed by the Steam Generation Department (Attachment 1). On the basis of this survey, the daily allowance for traveling maintenance crews in the Steam Generation and Nuclear Power Generation Departments has increased from \$36.00 in 1990 to \$37.00 in 1991.

The \$37.00 per diem is also applicable to parts of the Hydro Generation Department as specified in Letter of Agreement R2-85-14-PGE (Southern Area Hydro).
