Dear Mr. Bonbright:

In accordance with the discussions between Darrel Mitchell and Manny Mederos of my staff and Marsha Badella, David Bergman, and yourself on October 26, 1983, it is Union's understanding the Company and Union agree that employees returning to the active payroll from LTD on other than a permanent basis shall be paid at the current rate of their last permanent classification or the rate for the classification assigned, whichever is higher, notwithstanding the provisions of 112.10(c) and 7.10(b) of the Physical and Clerical Agreements, respectively.

Accordingly, appropriate wage adjustments are to be made for the individuals involved in the Letter Agreements listed above.
