Dear Mr. Lucas:

As agreed earlier, we have researched our payroll records for Don Short to determine what rate of pay was used during the following days on which rest periods occurred in 1973. These days, as you will recall, were singled out through your Mr. Wilder's exhaustive research.

> March 20, 1973 May 24, 1973 October 23, 1973 November 5, 1973

All days above, including rest periods, were paid at the upgrade rates of either Troubleman or Line Subforeman, except on May 24 when Mr. Short was eligible for a rest period, received same, but was paid at the Lineman rate (his base rate at that time). Furthermore, it would appear that he should have been paid at the Troubleman rate as he had earned the rest period as a Troubleman and served in that upgraded capacity for the three previous days. Therefore, we will execute a payroll transmittal adjusting Mr. Short's pay by \$1.14 (gross) for the subject rest period on May 24.

Attached is your original worksheet which we are returning for your records. With the above adjustment, I would consider this inquiry closed.
