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5. PERSONAL VEHICLE EXPENSES:

Maximum nontaxable vehicle mileage allowance allowed by the Internal Revenue Service is increased to 29 cents per mile, effective January 1, 1994.

The DMA application is now covered by Standard Practice 552-3, which also uses the maximum nontaxable vehicle mileage allowed by the Internal Revenue Service as the basis for its rate. As a result, the DMA rate is 29 cents per mile, effective January 1, 1994.

6. TRAVELING CREW EXPENSES:

Based upon the 1994 survey of reasonable daily traveling crew expenses, the rate is increased from \$38 in 1993, to \$40 in 1994. Attached is the 1994 survey.

7. SOUTHERN AREA HYDRO CREW EXPENSES:

Using the calculations agreed upon in LA 85-14, the rate established for Southern Area Hydro is increased from \$38 in 1993, to \$41 in 1994.
