Decals on Hard Hats

DIVISION MANAGERS DEPARTMENT HEADS PIPE LINE OPERATIONS MATERIALS GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NUCLEAR POWER GENERATION

There has been considerable discussion concerning what decals may be applied to the shells of the Company's insulated protective headgear (hard hats).

This matter has been reviewed by representatives of the departments involved, and it has been recommended that Standard Practice 571-1, Paragraph 11d be revised as follows:

- Only decals approved by the Safety, Health and Claims Department and furnished by the Company and a union decal approved by the Company may be applied to hat shells.
- Only one of each type decal shall be permitted on the hat shell such as one union decal, one safe driving award, one accident prevention award, one American flag, etc.
- Decals shall be placed on the sides or back and not be on the brim of the shell or extend more than three inches from the juncture of the brim and crown and shall not interfere with another decal.

The Standard Practice will be revised and released in the near future, and the above information should be disseminated to personnel under your jurisdiction as soon as possible.
