Working Prearranged Overtime

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

The issue concerns the bypassing of various certified Welders and Helpers at Moss Landing Power Plant on the weekends of January 24-25, 1976 and January 31-February 1, 1976 in order to avoid having them work 21 consecutive days. The record indicates that if the overhaul had been carried out as originally scheduled, the grievants would have worked beyond 19 consecutive days. Therefore, the Pre-Review Committee is of the opinion that the Division's interpretation of Section 208.23 of the Labor Agreement and the Labor Agreement Clarification dated July 14, 1975 was correct, and the assignments on the days in question were proper. However, the Division still has an obligation to balance the prearranged overtime at the end of the established accounting period.

When a settlement is reached by the Joint Grievance Committee, the Review Committee should be sent a copy of the final disposition.
