Denial of Overtime Pay, Rigger

April 1, 1977

MR. C. E. ALTMAN, Chairman East Bay Division Joint Grievance Committee

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Section 1B(2) of the Review Committee procedure, to the Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

The issue concerns the grievant, a Rigger, alleging that he should have been called out on emergency overtime to perform the work that was assigned on February 9, 1976, to the Night Maintenance Crew. The crux of the issue is one of the grievant's contractual rights to work emergency overtime, and in view of the Joint Grievance Committee's letter of December 16, 1976, which indicates there were no volunteers for emergency duty during the week of February 6 through February 13, 1976, in the Rigger classification, the Pre-Review Committee concludes that a violation of the Agreement did not occur, and the case closed without adjustment. However, the closure is without prejudice to either position of Company or Union as to the propriety of the assignment to the Machinist classification.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing, and the closure should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
