DECISION LETTER DECISION DPRE-REVIEW REFERRAL East Bay Division Grievance No. 1-134-76-134 P-RC 282 Operator-In-Training Allegedly Performing Relief Utility Operator Duties

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Section 1B(1) of the Review Committee procedure, to the Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

The grievance concerns the temporary assignment of an Assistant Operator from July 26, 1976, to August 26, 1976. The temporary assignment included a change in hours from the grievant's regular hours of work, 7:00 AM-3:00 PM to 8:00 AM-4:30 PM, with the workdays remaining the same. The temporary assignment was for the purpose of allowing the grievant to gain experience working as a Utility Operator although the grievant was given a vehicle and worked different hours than the regularly scheduled Utility Operators. In reviewing the Joint Statement of Facts, the Pre-Review Committee concludes that the assignment of the grievant was not substantially for the purpose of training and appears, in the main, for the purpose of providing relief for those regular Utility Operators on vacation during this period of time. <u>Therefore, as the</u> grievant was utilized predominantly as a temporary Utility Operator, she should be compensated accordingly pursuant to Titles 202 and 204 of the Labor Agreement.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing and the adjustment provided herein, and the closure so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
