Pipe Line Operations Grievance No. 11-8-76-8 P-RC 305 Overtime Assignment Not Made From Call-Out Sheet

October 18, 1977

MR. R. W. HORTON, Chairman Pipe Line Operations Joint Grievance Committee

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Section 1B(2) of the Review Committee procedure, to the Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

The issue concerns the call-out of a Transmission Mechanic who had not volunteered for emergency duty as opposed to a Gas Control Mechanic who had volunteered for the emergency overtime. The grievant is arguing that as a Gas Control Mechanic, he was qualified for the job assignment in question even though he normally would not have been called for this type of an assignment unless it is necessary to have a technical maintenance employee respond after the unit has been restarted. In view of Item Nos. 3, 5 and 6 of the Joint Statement of Facts, the Pre-Review Committee is of the opinion that a contractual violation did not occur inasmuch as the restarting of engine is work of either the Transmission Mechanic or Mechanic Welder, and, therefore, the grievant did not have a contractual right for the call-out.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing, and the closure should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
