Statement of the Grievance

This case concerns the General Construction, Station Department's former training program for Apprentice Electricians. Specifically, the employees complained that they had not been provided study time in accordance with the previous practice of the Department.

Decision

The Company and Union entered into a formal training program for Apprentice Electricians on July 30, 1979. Thus, whatever might have been the problem in the past, has been resolved by these negotiations. Therefore, this case is closed without adjustment and without prejudice to the parties' position relative to Section 107.1 of the Physical/Agreement.
