


Statement of the Case

On February 5, 1979, a grievance was filed on behalf of an Arc Welder requesting that the grievant be returned to his former headquarters. The request preceded a recommendation by a panel physician that his job commute be restricted to 75 to 85 miles. At the time the grievance was filed, the grievant apparently was working at Burney, which necessitated a commute from his home in Dixon. Since then, we are informed that the grievant has been relocated to Sacramento. Future transfers may, however, involve the foregoing restrictions.

Decision

On the basis of the foregoing, it would appear that the corrective action sought by the grievance has already been accomplished. For this reason, the case is closed.
