The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure to the Local Investigating Committee in accordance with the following:

The case concerns the failure of calling the grievant, a Lineman, in Hollister for emergency overtime as a Troubleman on July 9, 1980. The Joint Statement of Facts is silent relative to the on-call service procedure established for Troublemen in Hollister; and in reviewing Section 212.10 of the Physical Agreement, an answer to this grievance is not possible until the on-call service procedure is known and is given due consideration. Therefore, the Pre-Review Committee instructs the Joint Grievance Committee to determine the on-call procedure for Troublemen in Hollister and resolve the issue consistent with that procedure. In the event there is no procedure, then the case should be closed on the basis that a procedure will be established.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing and the closure so noted in the Minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

- 2. The Union will communicate directly with plant supervision at Morro Bay to establish candidates for the Safety Inspection Committee.
- 3. The Company is seeking to establish uniform safety guidelines for dress within the division steam department. These guidelines will not require long sleeve shirts while working in the machine shops.
- 4. Union requested follow-up from Safety Health & Claims for an injured employee. Company will pursue immediately.
- 5. Union requested that Moss Landing plant supervision clarify nature of available Code Orders for plant operators.
- 6. The Company informed that the new training program for clearances at steam plants is currently under review by the coordinator at G.O.-Steam Generation. Approval is expected soon.
- 7. The Company informed that requests for representation from Safety-Health & Claims should be directed to the division Personnel Department for referral to the appropriate representative.
- 8. Steam leak at Moss Landing lead value is currently under repair. Status of repair for leak at referenced reducing station will be determined.
