



These cases involve a question of temporary upgrade from Gas Construction Working Foreman C to Working Foreman B when assigned joint trench work.

Company and Union recently executed letter agreement 81-90-PGE which provides for such upgrade for joint trench work involving 15 or more structures or joint services.

Inasmuch as the two grievances involved installations of less than 15 structures or services, these cases are closed without adjustment and such closure should be so noted by the Joint Grievance Committee.

Gentlemen:

The IBEW filed two grievances in 1980 (Nos. 3-834-80-119 (P-RC 618) and 3-843-80-128 (P-RC 619)) which questioned the propriety of assigning Gas Construction Working Foreman C's to supervise "joint trench" jobs. The Union claims that, because of the complexity of the joint trench jobs, Working Foremen B's should be assigned such work, notwithstanding Exhibit X.

To resolve these grievances, without prejudice, it is proposed, pursuant to Section 304.4 of the Physical Agreement, that the following language be added to that presently in Exhibit X:

"Notwithstanding anything else herein contained, a Working Foreman B will be required on all Gas Construction jobs involving joint trench work for 15 or more structures or joint services."

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
