The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

This case concerns a Troubleman in Bakersfield who was given a one-day disciplinary layoff on November 4, 1980. The grievant was the No. 1 Troubleman signed up on the call-out list for emergency overtime. That evening, the No. 2 Troubleman was utilized to perform three hours of overtime work. The grievant was bypassed on the basis that he was suspended for disciplinary reasons.

After reviewing the facts of this case, the Committee agreed that it is inappropriate to call out employees who are on disciplinary layoff for emergency overtime.

This case is closed without adjustment.
