The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

This case involves the alleged failure of Company to call out grievant, a Lineman, for emergency overtime.

The grievant notified the Company of a change of his phone number, through the use of a Change of Address Form. Subsequently, a call was placed to the grievant's old phone number for emergency overtime. The grievant was not contacted, and upon determining that the grievant had notified the Company but not the on-call supervisor of the changed phone number, the grievant was also not charged with a refusal to respond. Upon further investigation, the Local Investigating Committee also discovered that the changed number which the grievant had given the Company was incorrect. It is, therefore, obvious that even had the on-call supervisor been given the grievant's new phone number, since it was incorrect, the grievant still would not have been contacted.

The Pre-Review Committee recommends that supervision involved in this headquarters establish a procedure to make sure that the on-call supervisor is aware of changed phone numbers for those who sign the weekly overtime list. The Committee further emphasizes that the employee has the responsibility to give the Company the correct phone number. As a result, the Pre-Review Committee agrees to settle this case without adjustment.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing and the closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
