The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:


This case involves a question of a contractual violation in requiring Plant Assistants to secure meters and cages onto pallets after they are repaired, but before they are shipped from the Gas Meter Shop in Fremont.

Considering all the evidence in this case, the Committee concludes that this work has historically been performed by the Plant Assistants and prior to that, by Helpers in the various meter shops before the work was centralized at the Gas Meter Repair facility. The evidence also suggests that there have been others from outside the facility who have assisted in this work from time to time, such as General Construction Field Clerks, Miscellaneous Equipment Operator B's and Helpers. There is further evidence in this case to suggest that in the Divisions, Gas Helpers perform some of these same functions of banding the materials to pallets.

In review of all the evidence of this case, the Committee concludes that the work in question has historically been performed by the Plant Assistants and is correctly assigned.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing, and the closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
