

As instructed by the Pre-Review Committee, a Local Investigating Committee comprised of Messrs. J. Roscoe, Departmental Shop Steward; S. A. Tamimi, Union Business Representative; W. Brossard, Supervisor of Maintenance; and P. N. Long, Supervisor of Labor Relations; met on February 17, 1982 to discuss this case. Mr. K. Carrig, Personnel Trainee, observed this meeting.

The Committee reviewed the additional information concerning this case and has concluded that it would be proper to pay the grievants at time and one half for the time worked on Saturday and Sunday, November 29 and 30, 1980, as the work performed could not be construed to be of an emergency nature.

Corrected transmittal sheets should be submitted and the employees paid based on the 1980 wage rates.

This case is considered closed.




