The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns the bypass of a Helper at Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant to an Instrument Repairman vacancy.

Facts of the Case

The grievant was given a written test and also interviewed to determine his qualifications to fill this jouneyman job. The Union grieved alleging that Company may not unilaterally establish tests to determine qualifications.

Discussion

The Company argued that the test was given to assist in the determination of the grievant's qualifications, that it was not the sole determinant, or a pass/fail test and, therefore, proper under the provisions of Section 205.11 of the Physical Agreement.

It was determined by the Pre-Review Committee that there were no qualified bidders for the vacancy. It was reclassified to Apprentice Instrument Repairman and awarded to the grievant. The parties were in agreement that the grievant did not possess the necessary knowledge or skill to fill the journeyman vacancy.

Decision

It was agreed to close this case without adjustment and without prejudice to the position of the parties with respect to the administration of the written test. Such closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating

Committee.
