

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(ii) of the grievance procedure to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

A Lineman grieved claiming that he was the No. 1 Lineman on the Title 212 emergency call-out list and was not utilized to work emergency overtime the evening of February 8, 1983. The Committee determined, based on the addendum provided by the Local Investigating Committee that a crew consisting of a Line Subforeman, Lineman and an Apprentice Lineman were working a job as an extension of the workday and that at 9:15 p.m., the Line Subforeman and Apprentice Lineman asked to be released. The Line Subforeman was replaced by the No. 1 Line Subforeman signed on the Title 212 emergency call-out list. The Apprentice Lineman was replaced by the only Apprentice Lineman signed on the Title 212 emergency call-out list. The Lineman continued to work on the same job until it was completed.

The Pre-Review Committee agreed that, inasmuch as the Lineman worked a continuation of the workday on the same job, that it was unnecessary to utilize the Title 212 emergency call-out list. The Committee agreed there was no violation of the Agreement and to close this case without adjustment. Closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
