· Dear Brother Olson:

On September 25, 1984, IBEW Business Representative Ed Caruso filed a formal grievance on your behalf, protesting your discharge from Pacific Gas & Electric Company. On October 12, 1984, a Local Investigating Committee met and collected testimony related to your termination. You were present at this meeting. At the LIC, Business Representative Perry Zimmerman conducted the LIC as primary representative of IBEW Local 1245. Since that time, Mr. Zimmerman has not been able to get in contact with you.

The Local Investigating Committee was unable to mutually agree to a disposition of the grievance filed on your behalf. On October 19, 1984, the grievance was referred to the next step of the grievance procedure, the Fact Finding Committee. Following discussion at the Fact Finding level on two occasions, the case was again referred to the next level of the grievance procedure, the Pre-Review Committee. The grievance has been before the Pre-Review Committee since February 22, 1985.

At a meeting of the Pre-Review Committee on March 15, 1985, a number of questions arose which are not answered in the Local Investigating Committee Report. In order to answer many of the questions, it will be necessary that we speak with you. However, to date, our efforts to contact you have been unsuccessful. During a recent absence of Business Representative Zimmerman, Business Representative Tamimi attempted to contact you at the address of record, unsuccessfully. Further, he was unable to reach you at the phone number of record. Mr. Tamimi contacted the Shop Steward at the Valleje yard in an attempt to locate you and was told by the Shop Steward that you may have left the area and moved to Oregon.

Because Local 1245 has not had any contact with you for approximately six months, there is a serious question of whether you wish to pursue your claim of an unjust discharge

In the event that I do not hear from you no later than Monday, May 6, 1985, I will assume you do not wish to pursue the claim of unjust discharge and will close out the case.
