Subject of Grievance - Creation and filling of Garage SubForeman position on the day shift in the Division Garage in Marysville.

Facts and Discussion - The Fact Finding Committee met on January 29 to discuss the case and to review the report of the Local Investigating Committee.

It was agreed that prior to January 1, 1980, there had not been a Lead Mechanic on days and that there was a Lead Mechanic on nights.

Based on Attachment B, Classification Wage Adjustments, effective January 1, 1980 (copy attached), the Division had reclassified its Lead Mechanic position on nights to a Garage SubForeman.

The Fact Finding Committee was unable to reach agreement and the case was referred to Pre-Review.

By letter dated June 10, the Pre-Reveiw Committee referred to subject grievance back to Fact Finding for settlement without adjustment and without prejudice to the position of either party.

Based on the above, this case is considered closed.
