## Grievance Issue

Grievants were not provided meals while attending agreed-to school.

### Facts of the Case

The four grievants are Linemen in the Line Construction Department. They attended a Basic Lead course on March 25 to April 12, 1985 in San Francisco Division located at 536 Treat Avenue.

These grievants were paid according to Subsection 301.4(a) during their attendance at this training course.

## Decision

The Committee agreed that this situation is covered by Subsection 301.9(d) and that the grievants should have been offered the option of Subsections 301.9(a) or (b). Since they were not given a choice prior to attendance at the school, the Committee agrees to pay the grievants the difference between \$22 and the paid per diem amount for the duration of the assignment at the Basic Lead school.

With this adjustment this case is closed, and such closure should be so noted in the minutes of the Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
