

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(i) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

## Subject of the Grievance

Company has contracted with courier services to deliver Company mail on the Taft and Coalinga routes. These deliveries were previously performed by Light Truck Drivers.

## Facts of the Case

On March 25, 1984, Company let contracts with two different courier services. The previous Light Truck Driver incumbents voluntarily left their positions; none were laid off.

On October 1, 1986, a single contract was let for all routes in the old San Joaquin Division.

## Decision

Company agrees to cease and desist contracting out the delivery of mail between Company facilities. This case and others involving this same issue are closed on this basis without prejudice to the positions of the parties in other cases involving Section 207.2 (24.5) of the Agreement.
