Subject of the Grievance

This case involves the alleged establishment of a joint-employer relationship with agency employees performing work in the Materials Department at Diablo Canyon.

Discussion

The grievance was filed on January 6, 1987 over the use of Bechtel and Waltek employees as Materialsmen. The Bechtel employees had a lead employee who handled administrative needs. However, they and the Waltek employees were directly supervised, trained and scheduled by PG&E supervisors.

On October 12, 1987, the parties executed Review Committee Decision No. 1637 which provided a cease and desist remedy on current grievances involving joint-employer status. Such status clearly existed in this case. Following RC 1637, Diablo Canyon has released all agency employees performing Materialsman work. Therefore, the cease and desist remedy from RC 1637 is appropriately applied to in this case.

On that basis, this case is considered_closed.
