The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee prior to its docketing on the agenda of the Review Committee and is being returned, pursuant to Step Five A(i) of the grievance procedure, to the Local Investigating Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

Subject of the Grievance

This grievance concerns whether supervisory personnel at Morro Bay Power Plant have been performing bargaining unit work.

Facts of the Case

The Fire and Safety Supervisor used to submit handwritten minutes of the Safety Committee meetings, meeting notices, and miscellaneous safety memos to a Routine Plant Clerk for typing and distribution. The supervisor began typing these documents into his personal computer and distributing copies without having them retyped by the Routine Plant Clerk.

Decision

The Pre-Review Committee agreed that the supervisor simply replaced his pencil with a keyboard and on that basis further agreed that no violation of the Agreement occurred. This case is closed without adjustment and such closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
